Saturday Workshop Information

Personal Testimony – After her encounter with Jesus, the inspired Samaritan woman convinced many from her city to come and listen to Jesus. Her witness was powerfully persuasive because it was her personal experience. People can, and will, argue with you about doctrine, but no one can resist your experience - which is your personal testimony. The workshop will help you to formulate and practice your testimony. [Vince Finnegan]

Evangelism Practice - Let's face it, practice is necessary to gain competence and confidence in any area of life, so why not evangelism? This interactive workshop will give you an opportunity to evangelize other Christians who are pretending to be unbelievers of various types. Not only will you gain hands on experience, but you will also learn by watching others. A caring and safe environment will provide an optimal learning experience for first-timers who have never tried to share their faith. [Sean Finnegan]

The Message – Jesus, his apostles and disciples provide many examples of what to say while witnessing. The message simply stated is: the Kingdom of God which includes the crucifixion

and resurrection of Jesus Christ. The focus of the workshop will be identifying what to say from the Scriptures and how to incorporate the message into daily commonplace conversations. [Victor Gluckin]

Starting Conversation – Many people feel uncomfortable, awkward, and even embarrassed when starting conversations with strangers. The workshop will include a presentation of a number of very simple techniques to start effective dialogues along with an opportunity to practice these methods. [John Cortright]

Confronting Obstacles and Fear - According to the book of Acts, when believers proclaimed the Gospel, most often there was some kind of obstacle to thwart their efforts. The common impediment then and now is fear. The aim of this workshop is to eliminate obstacles with proper instruction and practice. [Rose Cumella]

Overcoming Objections – God, eternal life, and judgment are subjects most people consider at some point in life. If they have not repented and accepted the lordship of Jesus Christ, they probably “justify” their behavior. Therefore, when hearing the Gospel message, they have set objections that are intended to put off the person speaking to them. The objections are the manifestation of their rationalization. This workshop will help you to anticipate these objections and to respond with biblical answers. [Mary Ann Yaconis]

Locating Places and People – Numerous suggestions for the best locations for effectively approaching people will be discussed. Most communities already have in place programs that people participate in to get help. Believers can be welcome to serve in these programs and gain opportunity to witness. Sharing ideas about how to disarm people by developing relationships that encourage trust and openness will be reviewed. [Chuck Cumella]

Love and Witnessing – Jesus said, “By this all men will know that you are my disciples, if you have love for one another.” The most compelling witness we have is the love we share with others.
